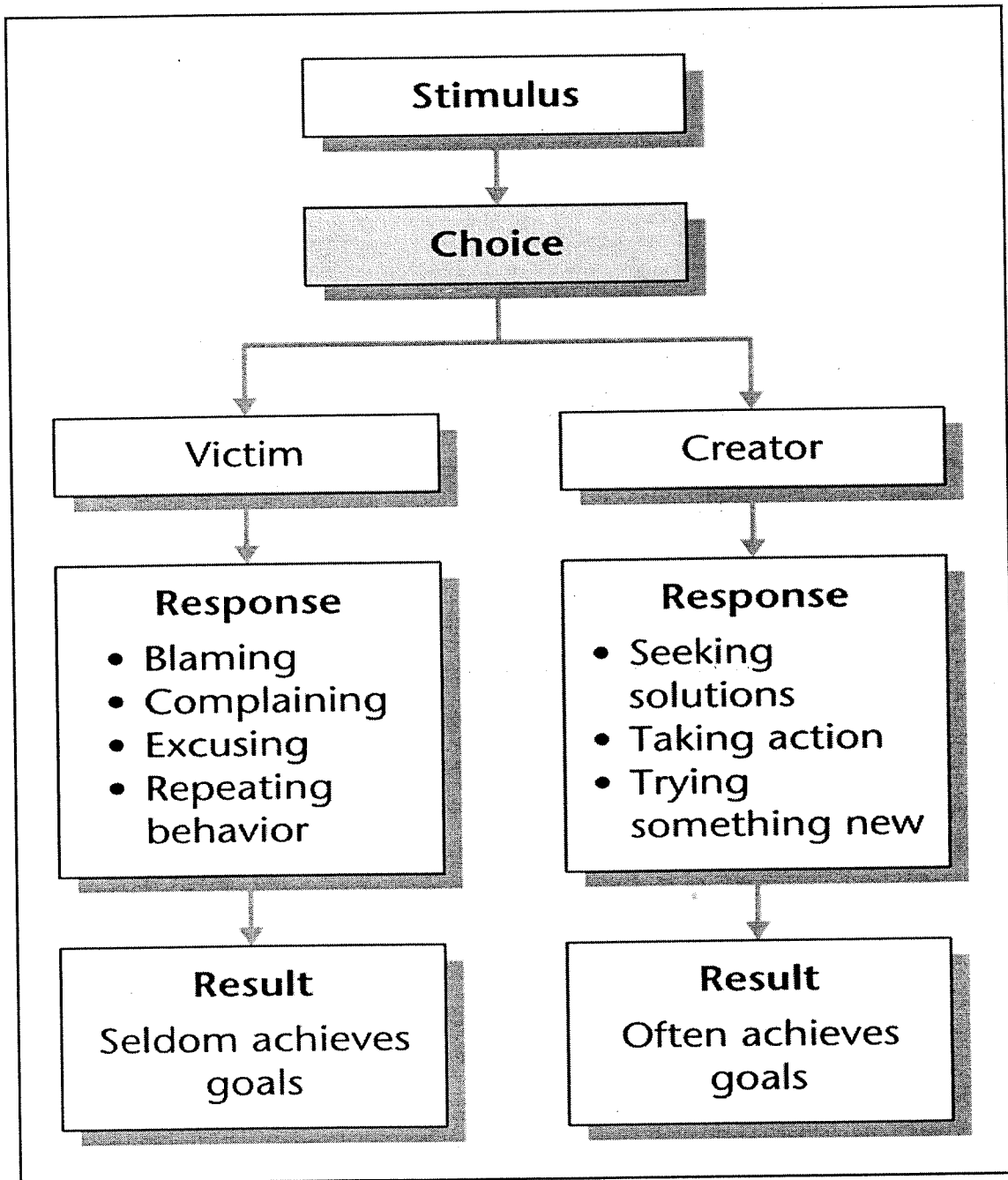


## The Language of Responsibility Model



VICTIM LANGUAGE	CREATOR LANGUAGE
<b>Victims Focus on their weaknesses</b> I'm terrible in this subject.	<b>Creators focus on how to improve</b> I find this course challenging, so I'll start a study group and ask more questions in class.
<b>Victims make excuses</b> The instructor is so boring he puts me to sleep.	<b>Creators seek solutions</b> I'm having difficulty staying awake in this class, so I'm going to ask permission to record the lectures.
<b>Victims complain</b> This course is a stupid requirement.	<b>Creators turn complaints into requests</b> I don't understand why this course is required, so I'm going to ask my instructor to help me see how it will benefit me in the future.
<b>Victims compare themselves unfavorably to others</b> I'll never do as well as John, he's a genius.	<b>Creators seek help from those more skilled</b>
<b>Victims blame</b> The tests are ridiculous. The teacher gave me an "F" on the first one.	<b>Creators accept responsibility</b>
<b>Victims see problems as permanent</b> I'll never understand this subject. It's a waste of time to study.	<b>Creators treat problems as temporary</b>
<b>Victims repeat ineffective behaviors</b> Going to the tutoring center is no help. There aren't enough tutors.	<b>Creators do something new</b>
<b>Victims try</b> I'll try to do better.	<b>Creators do</b>
<b>Victims predict defeat and give up</b> I'll probably fail. There's nothing I can do. I can't... I have to... I should... I quit...	<b>Creators think positively and look for a better choice</b>
